Rules and etiquette

Golf Course Rules

GORKI Golf&Resort follows the Rules of Golf as published and administered by the RGA.

Course rules are published on the scorecard.

In case of a temporary change of course rules, information will be posted on the first tee.

Eligibility to Play

A player must have a handicap of 36 or below to be allowed to play on the Champions course, for Club members maximum HCP is 54. Players with a higher handicap are permitted on the course only if accompanied by golf professional.

The use of alcohol is prohibited during a round and any player under the influence of alcohol will not be allowed on the course to play.

Balls

Driving range balls may not be used on the Champions course or the short course at any time.

Club Sets

Each golfer is obligated playing with their own club set. Usage of one set of club for two or more golfers is prohibited.

Pace of Play

Players are obligated to maintain a normal pace of play. One round must be completed in 4 ½ hours.

The Course Marshall will have full control of play and enforce all rules. Faster groups have the right to play through.

Dress Code

Effective on the golf course, putting green, driving range, and short course:

For men:

- Polo shirt or long-sleeved shirt
- Trousers
- Classic knee-length shorts (in hot weather)
- Important point: the shirt should always be filled, and trousers or shorts are necessary to wear with a belt.

For women:

- Polo shirt or long-sleeved shirt
- Trousers
- Classic knee-length shorts or skirt (in hot weather)

Only studded golf footwear and footwear with a rubber sole may be used on the golf course. Sandals, slippers, sneakers, tennis shoes, soccer and baseball cleats are prohibited.

Jeans, shorts longer than the knees, sleeveless polo shirts for men, mini-skirts and tops on straps and blouses/ shirts with a low neck for women are prohibited.

Mobile Phones

Phones must be switched to silent mode while playing on the course and Driving Range.

Golf Carts

Carts are not to be operated by anyone under the age of 18.

Limit 2 players per cart.

Carts may not be parked closer than 25 meters from the green.

Everyone who drives the car assumes responsibility for driving it, including for causing harm to health or causing material damage to themselves or other persons.

Before issuing a car, it is golfer's responsibility to familiarize themselves with the safety rules and to put a signature on a document at the Golf Department reception.

The Club Member who invited guests or spectators is responsible for their compliance with the safety rules for being on the golf course and in the training area.

Availability of Golf Carts is under Head Greenkeeper and Golf Director of the Club responsibility. Staff of the Golf Department may refuse to rent a car by their own decision.

Caddies

One caddy maximum per player during a round.

Caddies must be approved by the Golf Department before entrance onto the course.

Course Maintenance and Preservation

All players must replace divots and repair ball marks.

All players must rake footprints in sand traps.

Smoking

Is permitted only in designated areas.

Reporting Violations

If you witness any violation of the above rules, please notify Golf Department reception.

Rules for Corporate and Special Events

In case of special or corporate events the administration is obligated to notify club members on possible restrictions on club usage or disruptions of services in advance.

Club members have the first right to use the premises of club for the organization of corporate and special events.

Other

The Administration and Management of the Club have the right and authority to prohibit any games, trainings or other actions that, in their opinion, bring harm and infringe on the interests of any of the Guests of the Club and / or the Club itself. Prohibited: illegal activity; violation of the law on gambling; distribution on the territory of the Club of any type of advertising without the prior permission of the Club.

For non-compliance with the rules of the Club and golf etiquette, a member of the Club or a guest may be suspended from playing on the golf course and visiting the Club by the decision of Club Administration.
